Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative):

Altoona City Police Narcotics Division initiated an investigation regarding the distribution of marijuana within the City of Altoona, involving Patrick Oswalt and Joyce Cox. Tips were received through Push out the Pusher claiming Oswalt and Cox were bringing pounds of marijuana into Altoona for distribution. APD developed an informant and began making controlled buys in December of 2011. A total of (4) controlled buys were conducted and APD learned that Oswalt returned on 02-22-2012 from the Pittsburgh area with several pounds of marijuana. Oswalt was arrested after a controlled buy and APD obtained a search warrant for the residence of 2302 West Chestnut Avenue where the two stored the marijuana after making the run to Pittsburgh.

Upon execution of the search warrant, officers were able to seize approximately 2.5 pounds of marijuana, numerous items of paraphernalia, \$385.00 U.S. currency, and their Ford Explorer for forfeiture proceedings.
