APD developed an informant and began making controlled buys in December of 2011. A total of (4) controlled buys were conducted and APD learned that Oswald returned on 02-22-2012 from the Pittsburgh area with several pounds of marijuana. Oswald was arrested after a controlled buy and APD obtained a search warrant for the residence of 2302 West Chestnut Avenue where the two stored the marijuana after making the run to Pittsburgh.</p> <p>Upon execution of the search warrant, officers were able to seize approximately 2.5 pounds of marijuana, numerous items of paraphernalia, \$385.00 U.S. currency, and their Ford Explorer for forfeiture proceedings.</p> <p>Requesting agency is asking for reimbursement of approximately 38 hours overtime funds expended for the controlled buy and search warrant execution only on 02-22-12 into 02-23-12.</p>

The SW W/N/M39 and wife Jessica MOBLEY W/N/F-37 provided statements and charges will be pending. Statements indicated that Marc MOBLEY has been growing marijuana since 2005. His marijuana crops take 9 weeks to mature and that he has them staggered so that he obtains a mature crop every two weeks. The marijuana was sold in Blair, Cambria and Huntingdon counties. Seized were 111 Marijuana Plants, approx. 5 lb of processed marijuana, 14 compressed Hash Cylinders, 24 long guns, and 9 handguns. Assorted equipment associated with the indoor grow was also seized. Approx. \$500 in US Currency was seized. Officers also seized numerous financial records to assist in furthering the investigation and possible additional forfeitures.
