Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative): The Altoona Police Department has made four controlled buys of Heroin from Joseph Bongiorno and was planning on arresting him at the next large scale drug raid. Joseph is a long time distributor of Heroin and has a criminal record indicating such. Since the initial buys the PA State Police, Trooper Chuck Cheney, has received complaints from Bongiorno's, paramour's father who has expressed great concern relating to the drug activity taking place at the residence. According to Trooper Cheney, this male is reliable and has firsthand knowledge of traffic consistent with drug sales at Bongiorno's residence. The true concern expressed by this male is for the children living in the residence being exposed to the use and sale of Heroin. In speaking with Officer Crist, who is the investigating officer for the Altoona Police Department he indicated that his confidential informant can still make controlled purchases of Heroin from Bongiorno at the aforementioned residence. It is anticipated that upon the successful completion of the controlled buy, officers will execute a search warrant on the residence. It is anticipated that this operation will be swift and result in the removal of small children from the residence and the arrest of Joseph Bongiorno. The exact date of the operation is unknown at the current time due to coordination between multiple agencies and the pending approval of this request however it is our intent to complete this operation within the next 7 days. The Altoona Police Department will provide money for the purchase of controlled substances as well as informant fees that may be incurred. The manpower needed for this operation if yet to be determined, however it will be consistent with or lower than operation of a similar nature that OOT has funded in the past.

Over the past week Officer Crist has been making controlled buys of Heroin from "Tarzan" identified as Leslie T Brickhouse, through an unwitting known as "Pop's Doe" Pop's has been identified as James Bonner Jr. During the controlled buys Pops would take the recorded money from the CI and enter the apartment at 500 26th Street with Brickhouse and subsequently return and meet the CI with Heroin. The CI received information that Brickhouse was going to replenish his Heroin supply on 08/05/13. Upon confirming that Brickhouse had replenished his supply officers conducted a controlled buy in anticipation of obtaining a search warrant. The buy was successful and a sealed search warrant was obtained. Upon executing the search warrant officers located 1/2 pound of Marijuana, 165 bags of Heroin, and a little over two ounces of Cocaine. There was also \$863 in cash in the residence, two hundred of which was prerecorded task force funds from Previous buys. All totaled, the drugs have a value of approximately \$10,000 when calculated at current street sales costs. It should be noted that this operation was open and brazen in that several sales were taking place on the open sidewalk at various times throughout the daylight and evening hours. We have received numerous complaints via various sources about the drug activity in this area. Brickhouse has a criminal history that includes Delivery of a Controlled substance. Additionally there are mandatory drug weights involved as well as school zone enhancements which should result in a lengthy prison sentence for Brickhouse. We are asking for Operation Our Town reimbursement to cover the cost of this detail to include the precursor buy for the search warrant as well as the subsequent search warrant and associated duties.

Over the past several months several of the residents on the 300 block of 5th Avenue have been making regular calls to the Drug Hotline, push out the pusher, and the Altoona Police Department relating to a high volume of drug activity. Additionally the Altoona Police Department has been receiving detailed written reports from one of the neighbors three to five times a week outlining the heavy drug traffic coming from 314 5th Ave as well as an apartment building on 5th Ave at 3rd Street. A confidential informant was developed that made controlled purchases of Heroin out of the residence from Willie Solomon. Solomon is known to carry a hand gun and has close ties to various individuals that have been involved in shooting incidents in the City of Altoona. After the controlled buys were made it was determined that swift action should to be taken in order stop the flow of narcotics in the neighborhood so a search warrant was obtained. Given this information it was determined that the Altoona Police Department entry team should be utilized to breach the residence. Upon execution of the warrant it was determined that Solomon was not at the residence on this particular date however warrants for his arrest are forthcoming. During the operation numerous residents came outside in order to thank officers for helping them clean up their neighborhood. We are requesting Operation Our Town funding in order to cover the costs of this operation.

A controlled buy was arranged and CJ delivered a brick of Heroin (50 bags) to the CI. For a time the CI lost contact with CJ, however he was able to name others in Altoona that CJ was distributing narcotics to. On 08/13/13 the CI was once again able to contact CJ and arrange a purchase of raw Heroin that would equate to three bricks (150 bags). Initially CJ wanted the CI to travel to Johnstown however the CI advised him that he did not have transportation. CJ contacted the CI several times over a period of time indicating that he was on his way to Altoona and eventually arrived and delivered the Heroin in the restroom of Sheetz at 17th Street and 7th Ave. CJ was arrested after the delivery was completed and all APD buy money was recovered from CJ's pocket. CJ is facing potential mandatory weight charges from the March buy and definite weight and school zone mandatories for the delivery on 08/13/13. This operation was supplemented by the Directed Patrol Unit of the Altoona Police Department.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative): On 08/16/13 Officer from the Altoona police Department and Logan Township Police Department, in conjunction with the OAG/BNI Blair County Drug Task Force conducted a series of operations that targeted neighborhoods that are experiencing persistent high volumes of narcotics activity stemming from 314 5th Avenue and 228 5th Avenue. Neighbors in this area consistently have given detailed information several times a week concerning the drug sales taking place at the aforementioned locations. A confidential informant was developed that could purchase narcotics from Richard Montgomery at 228 5th Ave Apt. 6. A controlled buy of Morphine was set up and executed resulting in Montgomery's arrest. Montgomery immediately began to name persons that supplied him with Heroin and Crack over the past several months and indicated he would be willing to make controlled purchases from those people. A controlled buy was set up in which Michael Eades would deliver 1.5 grams of Heroin and 4 grams of Crack Cocaine. The buy was executed and Eades was taken into custody for Delivery of a controlled substance. It should be noted that buys on three other people were attempted one from a black male from Baltimore who was not in town at the time, one from another male who did not answer his phone, and one from Willie Solomon who indicated that he had heard that the CI was responsible for Eades arrest, and would not serve him. Information gathered from Montgomery has been corroborated with existing intelligence and efforts are being made to follow-up and make arrests utilizing other confidential informants. This operation as well as those in recent days were met with sincere thank you from the law abiding citizens that are closer to getting their neighborhood back.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative): Over a period of several months the Blair County/Altoona Area has experienced an explosion in the availability of Heroin. There are numerous people involved ranging from street level addicts selling to support their habit to predatory dealers selling for profit. Generally speaking Heroin is the most troublesome and widely available drug in Blair County. The effect of Heroin distribution and sales contributes greatly to violent crimes as well as Burglary, Theft, and Robbery which our area has realized a dramatic increase in as of late.

It is our intention to aggressively investigate and arrest people that are at both ends of the Heroin distribution spectrum in the coming months and make a substantial impact in availability of Heroin in Blair County. This will subsequently make a difference in the quality of life for the citizens of Blair county who continually find themselves victims of one or many of the aforementioned crimes.

These operations will take place through the remaining three months of 2013. Without operation Our Town funding many of these operations will not be possible. We are requesting \$5000.00 per month in October, November, and December of 2013 to help facilitate various investigations that will include buy busts and the execution of search warrants.

These operations will be periodically supplemented by officers that are on duty which does not impact the monies requested. Additionally the Office of the Attorney General BNI will provide monies for the purchase of narcotics and the Altoona Police Department will provide monies for miscellaneous expenses that come with these investigations.

In recent weeks the Altoona Police Department has developed a confidential informant who has indicated that Antony Williams is a high level distributor of Marijuana, Heroin, and Cocaine. Williams is from the Williamsburg area however he is a source of narcotics for many people in Blair County. The CI indicated that he previously had a relationship with Williams in which he sold Marijuana for Williams. In the past three months the CI indicated that he has observed Cocaine in William's possession and has purchased Heroin from him. 10/23/13 and 10/24/13 the CI was made arrangements with Williams to purchase Heroin through Williams' associates, one being Marty Doe and the other Shaun Paul Ross. Each time we successfully purchased heroin in varying quantities. It is our desire to launch a large scale investigation in the widespread narcotics distribution by Williams. This operation will require additional officers for controlled buy surveillance and additional monies for drug purchases which will be supplied by the OAG/BNI. The Altoona Police Department will cover other expenses that accompany narcotics investigations. It is anticipated that this investigation will result in a large scale investigation possibly a Grand Jury Investigation and numerous arrests for the distribution of various amounts of narcotics by numerous people throughout Blair County.
