Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative): On 01/09/14 officers initiated a narcotics investigation on Larry Thomas. Thomas Sold a brick of Heroin to a confidential informant in the presence of Sgt. Benjamin Jones who was working in an undercover capacity. The cost of the brick was \$350, however Thomas indicated that he could supply 2 bricks for \$600 because we would be buying in bulk. On 01/12/13 Sgt. Jones contacted the CI in order to set up the deal for \$600 worth of Heroin. Sgt. Jones again worked in an undercover capacity and picked Thomas up at his residence. Upon giving Thomas the money it became apparent that Thomas was stealing the City funds and he was subsequently arrested as a result of a vehicle stop. While interviewing the driver of the vehicle he admitted to purchasing Marijuana from a residence in Antis Township and delivering it to Thomas. As a result of this information it was determined that there was enough PC for a search warrant. The warrant was obtained and served on 656 Sabbath Rest Road in Antis-Township, During the search officers located a small amount of cash and approx. 3 ounces of Marijuana. As a result of this detail Larry Thomas was arrested for Theft as well as the aforementioned delivery of Heroin, Freet was arrested for Possession of a controlled Substance and a small amount of marijuana. The owner of the residence in Antis-Township, David McKnight was arrested for Delivery of a controlled substance for the delivery to Freet as well as PWID for the quantity of Marijuana located in the residence. The investigation is ongoing and more arrest will follow relating to the initial delivery of Heroin by Thomas.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity: On 01/15/14 Cpl. Moser received a call from a confidential informant who indicated that Rochester was making a trip to Baltimore to purchase \$1000.00 worth of Heroin to bring back to Altoona to distribute. Officers collected intelligence information about Rochester and found that he has a criminal history that includes Firearms Violations, Drug Deliveries, and Robberies. It was determined that the arresting Rochester would be high risk and superior manpower would be needed to ensure officer safety. Officers compiled an anticipatory search warrant for the vehicle that Rochester was to be operating and began to conduct surveillance at the intersection of Interstate 70 and Route 30 in Breezewood PA. The informant initially indicated that Rochester and Robenolt would arrive in Altoona around 10:00 AM. This information relating to the arrival time continually changed due to mechanical problems with the vehicle. At approximately 2:15PM officers observed the vehicle in question arriving West bound on Interstate 70. Officers conducted surveillance and followed the vehicle back into Clair County and conducted a high risk traffic stop on I-99 at 17th Street. Rochester and Robenolt were taken into custody and the search warrant was subsequently executed at the Altoona Police Station on the vehicle as well as the occupants, Rochested and Robenolt. As a result of the search officers located 10.0 Grams of Heroin on Rochester's person. The Heroin was in bulk form in capsules for repackaging for distribution on the streets of Altoona. The estimated street value of the Heroin was \$5000. Intelligence gathered in the investigation revealed that Heroin such as this goes for \$100.00 per ounce in Baltimore. Therefore Rochester spent approximately \$1000 in order to get his investment back and profit \$4000.00. Rochester and Robenolt were both charged with Criminal Conspiracy, Possession With Intent to Distribute Heroin, and Possession of Heroin. They were arraigned at the Blair County Central Booking Facility and incarcerated at the Jail in lieu of \$75,000 straight cash bail. This operation was supplemented in part by regular duty hours from the Blair County DA's Office as well as the Altoona Police Department.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative): On 01/31/2014 officers from the Altoona Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a Lincoln Aviator that was being operated by Joshua Barr. Barr was subsequently arrested for DUI (controlled substance) and asked officers to return the car keys to his girlfriend in his residence. Prior to doing so officer noticed a second Lincoln Aviator running in a parking space adjacent to their vehicle stop. A visual inspection of the vehicle revealed a bag of Heroin laying on the car seat. Officers proceeded to make contact with Shirley Nash in the residence of 2122 18th Street. Officers determined that their safety was at risk and they needed to check the residence for other persons. In doing the search officers located Heroin and cash in plain view in the master suite. At this point the residence was secured and a search warrant was obtained. In executing the search warrant officers located 237 bags of Heroin, \$7000.00 in cash, a stolen 9mm handgun, and AK-47 assault rifle. As a result of the search it was determined that there was enough probable cause to arrest all three of the aforementioned targets for Criminal Conspiracy and related weapons and drugs violations. Additionally there were three search warrants obtained and executed on vehicles, stemming from this incident.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity over the past month officers from the Altoona Police Department have been receiving complaints from the area of 1526 5th Street relating to the distribution of Heroin from that residence. Intelligence information indicated that there were two black males in the residence at various times distributing narcotics. One of the males is from Philadelphia and the other is from Pittsburgh. The indications are that the males would reside in the attic area of the residence while in town and use John Jukes as a middle man. Through the course of this investigation officers have made five successful controlled buys from the residence with the most recent being with the use of an undercover officers purchasing Heroin with an unwitting target that went to the residence. After the unwitting emerged from the residence he indicated that there was a substantial amount of Heroin in the residence and that if we needed anymore that night or in the future, he would facilitate getting it for us. A search warrant was executed at the residence which resulted in minimal seizure of Heroin. It is believed that Jukes swallowed an unknown quantity of Heroin while entry officers were making their way onto the second floor. The operation resulted in two in custody arrests for simple possession. There are additional charges pending for various prescription medication violations as well as tampering with evidence charges against Jukes. The previous buys will be filed in the near future as the CI is nearing the end of his cooperation with police.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity: Through an ongoing investigation officers have identified a high level Heroin Dealer in the Altoona Area. This investigation has been ongoing and financially supported by OOT, the Altoona Police Department, OAG/BNI/, and the Blair DA's office. We have made several controlled buys of Heroin which have resulted in unforeseen expenses due to the length of time each buy is taking. It appears as though the target operates predominately during the night time hours and is purposefully unpredictable and unreliable in an attempt to elude law enforcement. Generally, they buys have taken between two and 6.5 hours to complete. The buys have also required additional manpower for surveillance purposes due to the familiarity of the suspects to law enforcement and our tactics. At the current time arrangements are being made in order to secure additional funding to help further the investigation, however the CI in the case is regularly active and purchases relatively large quantities of Heroin several times a week. In order to continue this investigation we are requesting an additional \$5000.00 to cover current overages in the current line item and continue the investigation.

Over the course of two months officers developed a CI that could purchase quantities of Crack Cocaine from Lamont Valentine. During the operations the CI was consensualized and an audio/video recorder was placed on his person during the buys. On 02/05/14 officers obtained a search warrant for the residence. Upon executing the search warrant officer located approximately 4 ounces of Crack Cocaine and Powder Cocaine. Additionally officers seized \$2500 in cash. They were transported back to the Altoona Police Department and held in anticipation of obtaining a detail specific search warrant.

The males were taken into the Altoona Police Department and strip searched prior to placement into the holding cell. During this time the first male was extremely uncooperative during the search and had to be manually assisted in complying with verbal commands relating to the search. During the search a quantity of Crack Cocaine was retrieved from his Anus and it was determined that he had swallowed an unknown quantity of what we presumed to be Crack Cocaine, given the residue in his mouth. At this point it was determined that the individual needed medical attention for his safety and in order to determine if we could retrieve any more narcotics from his person. At this point two officers were assigned to transport him to the hospital while Det. Brandt compiled an additional search warrant. Upon receipt of the second search warrant officers searched and dismantled the vehicle that they arrived in only to find various packaging materials. After a substantial period of time it was found that the hospital intended on admitting one of the suspects for 12 hours for observation and possible recovery of narcotics. Officers were instructed to maintain watch over the suspect until such time as evidence was recovered or the male was discharged. After it was determined that the hospital was going to extend the admittance time to 24 hours arrangements were made to have him arraigned in the hospital and turned over to the custody of Blair County Prison.

Both individuals were charged with Criminal Conspiracy, PWID, Possession of a Controlled Substance, & Criminal Use of a Communication Facility. Bother were eventually lodged in Blair County Prison.
