Summary: A joint operation "Operation Night Hawk" with PA State Police and local police agencies throughout ALL of Blair County. DUI-drug enforcement experience titled Operation Nighthawk. This two-day program will be conducted at the PennDOT District 9-0 Building, 1620 North Juniata Street, Hollidaysburg, Pennsylvania on April 24th and 25th, 2015. This unique program combines classroom instruction (briefing) in DUI - DRUG enforcement and motivational information which will help the attending officers with the extensive saturation-roving patrol. We will be mixing Troopers, and municipal officers to promote two (2) office units for safety and better enforcement efforts. The Pennsylvania State Police has conducted this program for the past thirteen years throughout the Commonwealth with tremendous success.

This operation will be under the supervision of myself and Sergeant Rodney Estep of the Hollidaysburg Borough Police Department, as well as PA State Police (for the Troopers). During the operations, officers from each agency will be teamed together in two officer vehicles (each different agencies). We are looking at 15 County Officers, plus Troopers of the Pa State Police. The requested funding would be for the Blair County Officers, as PA State Police will be funding their Troopers under a different process.

This two (2) day event will begin each day at 7:00 p.m. and conclude at 2:00 a.m. The goal of the saturation patrol is to have a highly visible police presence on an evening/night across all of Blair County. This is an attempt to reduce crime, including assaults, robberies and drug-alcohol related incidents.

Kelley stated that Valentin had a backpack at his residence which contained heroin. Officers seized the back pack and obtained a search warrant which contained approximately (1) brick or 50 packets of heroin. Both Kelley and Valentin face additional charges from previous deliveries.

Officers then conducted a buy bust on James Anderson. Anderson delivered (3) packets of heroin to the CI and was arrested at his residence after the buy. In Blair County, the State of Pennsylvania and throughout entire United States law enforcement has seen an increase in heroin and prescription medication usage and illegal drug distribution. Heroin and prescription drugs are the leading cause of drug over doses resulting in death. It has been reported that 2013 was the first time ever that more people died from drug overdoses than from traffic accidents. The increase of heroin and prescription drugs was one of the main factors noted. In 2013 twenty-two people died from heroin overdoses in Blair County.

Law enforcement is aware that these narcotics are transported into the State of Pennsylvania and the County of Blair by gangs and other illegal organizations. With these organizations come an increase in crime and violence that includes robberies, assaults, shootings, and homicides.

Young adults are also starting to use and abuse drugs specifically heroin and prescription pills at an earlier age due to the accessibility of the illegal sale of narcotics. Based on reliable intelligence information Mexican Drug Cartels are flooding the country and more specifically the State of Pennsylvania with opiates to include heroin and prescription drugs.

The PA Office of Attorney General and the Blair County Drug Task Force will conduct narcotics investigations involving heroin and prescription medications in the County of Blair. This request will cover overtime for task force officers to complete this mission.

Potts currently resides at 203 Cedar Blvd, Hollidaysburg, PA 16648. Operation Our Town has received several complaints from neighbors living near Pott's residence. The complaints have been of high traffic in and out of the residence for short periods of time and suspected drug activity. The Blair County Drug Task Force executed a search warrant on Potts' residence in 2007 and a consent search was conducted at his business, Mr. Paving and Street Print. No drugs were seized as a result of the two searches, however, it was determined that a large quantity of marijuana was recently moved from a gun safe/vault at Potts' business. Agents and officers noticed marijuana seeds in the safe and a strong odor of packaged marijuana. The Blair County Drug Task Force has also received complaints in the past from other anonymous individuals that Potts was a large marijuana dealer.
