Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative: On 1-14-16 members of the Blair County Drug Task Force conducted a controlled purchase of marijuana from Alex Saylor and Tyler Glunt. Officers continued surveillance after the controlled delivery and followed Saylor as he made additional deliveries in the Altoona Area. A vehicle Saylor was traveling in was stopped and he was arrested. Officers seized \$446.00, an ounce of marijuana and a small amount of cocaine from Saylor. Saylor cooperated with officers and provided a statement. An additional (2) ounces of marijuana was seized from Saylor's vehicle, which he had parked at a local parking lot. Saylor also provided information allowing officers to obtain a search warrant for a residence that Tyler Glunt used as a "stash house". Officers arrested Glunt at his residence, 2425 7th Ave and obtained search warrant for that residence and the "stash house", 217 3rd Ave Rear. Officers recovered \$623.00 from Glunt and executed the search warrants. Officers recovered (4) lbs of marijuana, a food saver vacuum sealer, vacuum bags and other packaging material from the "stash house". Officers recovered (2) firearms, a small amount of marijuana and boxes with used packaging material indicating Glunt was having marijuana shipped in the mail from California from his residence. Saylor was released and will be arrested at a later time. Glunt was transported to Blair County Central Booking for processing and arraignment and is also on bail currently for a previous drug case where he is charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver over 40 lbs of marijuana.

On duty hours were also utilized for this detail with Sgt Sapienza, Sgt Merriil, Ptlm Swope, Agent Brandt and Agent Sinisi.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative: On 2-2-16 officers received information from a confidential informant that Terron Miller and Miranda McCulley were traveling to Johnstown to re-up their supply of heroin. The CI stated that Miller asked her to give them a ride to do so. The CI stated she gave Miller and his girlfriend a ride (1) time previously to re-up their supply of heroin.

Officers followed the CI to pick up Miller and McCulley in Altoona. The CI then was followed to SR219. The CI drove Miller and McCulley to the Prospect Homes area of Johnstown. The CI sent officers a text message stating when they were leaving Johnstown to return to Altoona. Officers were conducting surveillance at Sheetz in Ebensburg and observed the CI's vehicle stop at that location as planned. The CI went to the bathroom and confirmed they had heroin in the vehicle. The CI's vehicle was followed to Altoona and a vehicle stop was conducted. Miller and McCulley were both arrested. Officers seized (102) packets of heroin and \$300.00 in currency. The heroin seized had the same "stamps" as heroin being recovered in Johnstown which is leading to overdoses in the City.

McCulley and Miller were transported to Blair County Central Booking. Both face additional charges.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative: The Altoona Police Department began an investigation into heroin trafficking by Nathan Foor. As a result of the investigation officers determined Foor's source of heroin was a male from York Pa named Wayne Davis. Davis appears to be a large scale heroin trafficker selling bricks of heroin in the Altoona area. Officers have received information from other CI's that Davis was their source for heroin and he subsequently shut them off after they were arrested or had police contact. A confidential informant was introduced to Davis by Foor and officers are able to purchase bricks of heroin directly from Davis.

Trooper Schaefer (PSP) also had an active investigation into Davis and his source of heroin, believed to be Lawrence Francis, also from York Pa. The Altoona Police Department, PSP and PA OAG wish to continue a joint investigation into the trafficking of heroin by Francis, Davis and their associates in the Blair County Area. Officers plan to continue to make controlled purchases of heroin from Davis and his associates.

This request is to cover overtime expenses accrued by members of the Blair County Drug Task Force until the completion of said investigation. If additional funds are needed, a separate request will be compiled. Money for buys will be covered by PSP, APD and the PA OAG.

Officers obtained an arrest warrant for Taylor. When Taylor arrived in Altoona to deliver the heroin he was arrested on the warrant. Taylor had 2,600 packets of heroin on his person he was going to deliver to the CI. William Wingate and Isaiah Brown also were arrested.

Taylor, Brown and Wingate were all transported to Blair County Central Booking for processing and arraignement.

As a result of the search warrant Quazil Garland was arrested and evidence was seized to corroborate the case in Altoona. Garland, Darryn Corbett and Nikita Dillard were all arrested by Harrisburg PD for a stolen handgun that was recovered in the residence. After the delivery occurred officers moved in to arrest Fitzcharles for the delivery. Fitzcharles was non-compliant and an officer attempted to open his driver door. Fitzcharles then placed his vehicle into drive and fled, partially dragging the officer with his vehicle. A brief vehicle pursuit occurred before it was terminated for safety concerns. Fitzcharles was driving a high rate of speed and drove into oncoming traffic on the wrong side of the roadway.

Officers attempted to locate and arrest Fitzcharles at his residence with negative contact. The CI stated Fitzcharles was on his way to Johnstown to obtain more heroin. An arrest warrant was obtained for Fitzcharles and a BOLO was given to Cambira County 911.
