Wissinger eventually agreed to sell the CI a half of a brick of heroin (consistent with 25 packets) for \$180.00. The CI made the deal and gave the signal he had obtained the heroin. As Wissinger and Shirley began to drive off a vehicle stop was conducted and Wissinger and Shirley were taken into custody.</p> <p>The vehicle was searched and officers located paraphernalia, the buy money, additional heroin and other narcotics. Shirley also had paraphernalia on her person. Shirley was eventually released and will be arrested at a later time. Wissinger was transported to APD and eventually BCP in lieu of bail, probation detainer and BCSD warrant.</p>

Officers conducted surveillance on Herring's residence, 2410 Maple Ave and an illegal club which he operates known as "The Shake" at 922 7th Ave. Officers were able to arrest Darwin Herring after he left his residence in a vehicle. Herring also was arrested for possession of a small amount of marijuana. Officers then went to the Shake to search for Dontae Herring. Officers observed a Keltec .223 handgun and secured the premises for a search warrant. Officers seized a small amount of cocaine in addition to the handgun.</p> <p>Dontae Herring was entered into NCIC as wanted. Adams and Darwin Herring were transported to BCP.</p>

In speaking with Mannarino and Martz, officers were able to obtain a search warrant for a residence in Logan Twp, 505 Earnhardt Dr, due to that resident, Angel Santos having drugs and being in possession of a stolen .45 caliber handgun (reported stolen from Logan Twp). Officers executed the search warrant and arrested Santos at the residence. The stolen handgun was recovered along with a small amount of marijuana and paraphernalia.</p> <p>Mannarino was lodged in BCP on a state parole detainer and new charges for PWID and related offenses. Martz was lodged in BCP on a county probation detainer and charges will be filed at a later time for the PWID. Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative: On 4-6-18, officers of the Altoona Police Department were dispatched to 831 5th Ave for a report of shots fired at that location. Officers detained Gregory McQueen at that location. Additional manpower was called in to assist with the investigation. Upon searching McQueen, officers located a box containing (23) packets of heroin, a baggie containing approx. 1/2 gram of heroin, (70) new unused heroin bags and (2) cut straws. McQueen was arrested and transported to APD.

Through investigation officers learned that Aaron Waddell and Malik Johnson had gone to McQueen's residence to either collect or pay money from a drug debt. Evidence revealed that McQueen had fired a handgun at Waddell's vehicle as he fled 5th Ave. Witnesses then saw McQueen flee into his residence.

Five search warrants were prepared and executed for the residence of 831 5th Ave, (2) vehicles in front of the residence, Waddell's cellular phone and a GSR kit that was used to swab McQueen's hands.

As a result of the house search warrant officers recovered a .38 special revolver with (5) live rounds and (1) spent round in the cylinder. McQueen was a person not to possess firearms from previous drug delivery convictions. A criminal complaint was compiled and McQueen was transported to Blair County Prison for processing and arraignment.
