On May 5, 2021 members of the Blair County Drug Task Force executed multiple search warrants throughout the borough of Tyrone.

At approximately 1655 hrs. officers/agents executed the first warrant at 1311 Blair Ave. Tyrone, Pa. Upon execution of the search warrant Richard Allen Ewing (42) of Tyrone was detained outside the residence and officers/agents entered and secured the home.

Inside the residence officers/agents observed in plain view a substantial amount of crystal methamphetamine was observed throughout the residence.

A search of Ewing person yielded a fully loaded .45 caliber semi-automatic handgun, approximately three (3) ounces of crystal methamphetamine, approximately twenty five (25) grams of psilocybin mushrooms, and \$330.00 US Currency. Ewing was then transported to the Tyrone Borough Police Department.

Through the course of the investigation officers/agents were able to obtain a second search warrant for 1311 Bald Eagle Ave. Tyrone another residence that Ewing frequented, upon a search of the residence officers/agents located approximately two (2) ounces of marijuana and \$2,320.00 US Currency.

Officers also initiated a traffic stop on a Dodge Durango which had left the 1311 Bald Eagle Ave. address which was impounded and officers/agents obtained a search warrant for the Dodge Durango. A search of the Durango yielded additional crystal methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia.

It was found through the investigation that Ewing had a criminal history which included a conviction for a Felony, Aggravated Assault charge which prohibited him from legally possession a firearm.

At the conclusion of all three (3) search warrants officers/agents recovered a fully loaded .45 caliber handgun, approximately six (6) ounces of crystal methamphetamine valued at approximately \$6,000.00, approximately two (2) ounces or marijuana valued at approximately \$400.00, twenty five (25) grams of Psilocybin Mushrooms valued at approximately \$750.00, \$2,650.00 US Currency, and multiple pieces of drug paraphernalia to include digital scales.

Ewing was transported to the Blair County Prison Central Booking where he was arraigned by Magisterial District Justice DeAntonio where bail was placed at \$80,000 straight cash bail, Ewing was unable to post bail and is currently being housed at the Blair County Prison awaiting his preliminary hearing. Ewing is charged with three (3) counts Possession with Intent to Deliver, Convicted Felon not to Possess a handgun, Firearm not to be carried without a license, and three (3) counts Possession of a Controlled Substance.

Detailed Investigative Goals and Scope of Drug Activity (attach additional sheets of paper as needed for narrative: On 9-16-21 members of the Altoona Police Department received information that Jayson Hodges of Trafford Pa may have been involved in the armed robbery that occurred on 9-14-21 at Juniata Cards, 1019 N 4th Ave Altoona. Detectives coordinated with the Trafford Police Department and conducted surveillance at Hodges' residence on the 400 block of Duquesne Avenue Trafford Pa. APD Detectives observed the vehicle used in the armed robbery parked in front of the residence and were able to identify the vehicle by unique stickers observed in surveillance video after the robbery. Additionally, Detectives observed Hodges on the roof of the residence wearing the same pants and shoes as the actor in the robbery. Based on the observations, Detectives consulted with Blair County District Attorney Peter Weeks and Trafford Police officers, at which time it was determined there was enough probable cause to obtain a search warrant for the residence in Trafford Pa.

While officers were compiling the search warrant, Hodges left the residence on a bicycle and was detained a short distance away from the residence by Trafford Police. Altoona Police Detectives provided Hodges with his Miranda warnings and questioned him in regards to the armed robbery. Hodges confessed to the robbery and stated that inside his residence were several boxes of sports cards from the robbery, which he had opened. Hodges also admitted the pants and shoes he was wearing were the same clothes he wore during the robbery. Hodges stated the sweatshirt he wore was also inside the residence and the plastic bin he used was on the front porch. Hodges told Detectives that he had thrown away the hat, face coverings and gloves that he wore during the robbery. Hodges also admitted the gun he used during this incident was real and he had stolen it from a residence in the Greensburg area of Pa. Hodges stated the gun had ammunition in the magazine but not the chamber and he had hidden the gun in the duplex beside his residence. Hodges stated he had spent the money he obtained from the robbery on Halloween decorations and other items. When asked about how he knew about the card shop in Altoona, Hodges stated that he had purchased sports cards from the shop approximately 20 years ago and was able to recall one of the owners by his first name.

A search warrant was obtained from a Magisterial District Judge in Westmoreland County and executed on the residence and the vehicle. Officers recovered sports cards, clothing from the robbery, a cellular telephone, a tablet, a plastic tote with purple handles and a Ruger P95 9mm handgun with (9) rounds of ammunition in the magazine.

Jayson Hodges waived bail arraignment in Westmoreland County and was transported to Blair County. A criminal complaint was compiled charging Hodges with Robbery, Persons not to Possess a Firearm, Firearms not to be carried without a license, Receiving Stolen Property, Unlawful Restraint, Terroristic Threats, Simple Assault, False Imprisonment, Recklessly Endangering Another Person, Tampering with Evidence and Retail Theft.

Hodges was also found to be on State Parole and was convicted of previous Felony Burglary offenses which prohibits him from owning or possessing firearms.
