The Altoona Police Department has experienced a recent increase in drug overdose death cases. The department has recently trained additional officers to assist in investigating drug overdose death cases, in an attempt to develop the cases and make arrests for drug delivery resulting in death and drug delivery. With the increase in drug overdose deaths reported this year, the department has seen an increase in operational costs to investigate these cases. The Altoona Police Department requests \$7,500.00 in OOT funding to be used and assist in covering overtime expenses for officers, to include conducting search warrants and off-duty officers being called in on time off to conduct these investigations. This request will be used to supplement City Funds, which will also be used in conjunction with the request, to continue to investigate overdose deaths.

On Wednesday, June 22, 2022 Cpl Nixon (Altoona PD) and Ptlm Brandt (Allegheny Twp PD) responded to E. Altoona, PA for a narcotics investigation. PA State Parole agents had conducted a home check with the person and located suspected fentanyl in his pocket. Cpl Nixon and Ptlm Brandt obtained a search warrant for this apartment and executed same this date. Approximately 26.5 grams of suspected fentanyl was seized along with a large quantity of packaging material and paraphernalia. Also located were blender bottles with suspected fentanyl residue throughout as well as sifting devices. Was interviewed by Officers and reported that the powdery substance contained fentanyl and a horse tranquilizer he heard was Xylazine. The provided limited information about his Philadelphia source of these narcotics but was confident his source could deliver additional narcotics to him within hours of being contacted the fentanyl/xylazine substance to be very potent and required those who used it to frequently inject more to maintain a high. The alleged to know of approximately 5 other individuals in the Altoona area who were receiving this substance to distribute. A parole detainer was issued for and he was charged with Possession with intent to deliver, possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, and possession of a small amount of marijuana.

On Monday, June 20, 2022, Ptlm. Ketner conducted a Controlled Buy and subsequent Arrest of the Subject, namely Samuel Broadrick, utilizing a Confidential Informant. A Controlled purchase of suspected Heroin/Fentanyl was made out of a residence located at 1925 6th Avenue in the City of Altoona. A traffic stop was conducted after the Controlled purchase was made and the subject was taken into custody. Ptlm. Ketner did recover approximately one (1) gram of suspected Heroin/Fentanyl from the Confidential Informant.

Samuel Broadrick was transported back to the Hollidaysburg Borough Police Department, at which time he was interviewed by Ptlm. Ketner. Broadrick provided Ptlm. Ketner with information regarding the individual living at 1925 6th Avenue, from whom he had purchased said Controlled Substance. Broadrick also provided other information regarding persons of interest selling Controlled Substance within the City of Altoona and surrounding Areas.

Broadrick was transported to the Blair County Prison and lodged on an outstanding Arrest Warrant through the Allegheny County Sheriff's Department.

On June 29, 2022 officers from the Freedom Township Police Department, Greenfield Township Police Department, and the Blair County Drug Task Force were called to assist the two (2) Pennsylvania Constables who were serving a warrant from MDJ Blattenberger Office.

Upon the PA Constables serving the warrant they made contact with the female homeowner who invited the Constables into the residence. Upon entering the residence the Constables observed multiple pieces of drug paraphernalia and controlled substances in plain view. The Constables then requested assistance from the Greenfield Township Police Department and the Freedom Township Police Department.

Upon officers arriving on scene a patrolman from the Freedom Township Police Department contacted agents from the Pennsylvania Attorney General Office to assist with compiling and executing a search warrant on the residence.

A search warrant was compiled and executed at the residence at which time officers and agents located inside the residence additional drug paraphernalia and controlled substances.

Due to the search warrant several officers had to be called in to assist with the search warrant. Our department and the Blair County Drug Task Force is requesting reimbursement for the overtime hours incurred by this incident. Assistance with this cost would be greatly appreciated.

Through the course of multiple narcotics investigations conducted by members of the Blair County Drug Task Force, community member tips such as those provided through the Push Out the Pusher (POTP) hotline, and proactive patrol interdiction efforts, the Altoona Police Department has identified a number of locations and residences of high drug activity. \$5000 of Operation Our Town funds is requested to provide financial support to the Altoona Police Dept in order to conduct additional saturation patrols, surveillance details, interdiction activities, and to further the investigations into these targeted areas. The areas to be focused on primarily are listed below.



Due to increased call volume during the summer months, patrol units cannot dedicate enough time to effectively combat the drug activity in these areas. The requested funding would be utilized to place proactive Officers in a position to solely focus on investigations into those distributing narcotics among the community. These details will also be tailored to include any future areas identified by continued investigations and additional Push Out the Pusher notifications.

Meyers' coconspirator, Clifford Baxter, was unable to be located. Officers further attempted to serve warrants for John Setser, Bridget Bark, and others wanted by the Altoona Police Dept and Blair County Sheriff's Office.			
Officers conducted twenty field contacts and thirty-two vehicle stops. Three pursuits were initiated. The first vehicle pursuit ended after the operator evaded apprehension on foot. On November 23, 2022 Officers from the Tyrone Borough Police Department and other agencies participated in a saturation detail in the northern end of Blair County. Earlier in the day, an officer from the Tyrone PD made a vehicle stop. Both occupants of the vehicle were wanted by the Blair County Sheriff's Office. Also located during the stop was a glass pipe w/ residue inside commonly used for smoking illegal substances and 13 bags of suspected heroin. The vehicle was impounded and a search warrant was obtained. During the search of the vehicle 4741 bags of heroin, 3.5 grams of crystal methamphetamine, a Suboxone strip, and a Hi-Point .45 ACP handgun were located. 2 individuals were arrested for possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance and related offenses due to this stop

Also, during the detail officers encountered individual that was in possession of just under ½lb of medical grade marijuana and did not possess a medical marijuana card. This individual will also be arrested for possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance.

In addition to the felony arrests, officers made 9 traffic stops resulting in 1 citation and 6 warnings as well as 10 field contacts during the detail

This search warrant and the subsequent saturation detail required officers from 4 police departments and a total of 12 police officers. The participating departments are requesting reimbursement for the overtime hours incurred by this incident. Your assistance with these costs will be greatly appreciated.
