Mr. King:

Thank you for your inquiry to the County of Bedford, Pennsylvania with your request for information pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right-To-Know law.

As the Right-to-Know Officer, I received your request via email on August 12, 2022, whereby you requested: Pursuant to the Right-to-Know Law, 65 P.S. § 67.101 *et seq*, we request and require the following public records within five business days:

- 1) All records pertaining to past and ongoing services provided to Bedford County by Susquehanna Accounting & Consulting Services Inc. Including those related to the disbursement of CARES Act and other COVID relief funds. Including but not limited to bids, contracts, invoices, approvals, meeting minutes, emails, and all other forms of correspondence, between January 1, 2020, and August 12, 2022.
- 2) All records of correspondence between Corey Troutman and Bedford County Commissioners both past and present. Including but not limited to emails, references to conversations in documents, transcriptions of correspondence whether written or typed, or any other form of communication between January 1, 2020, and August 12, 2022.

We will not oppose a 30-day extension, provided the time is used for a proper good-faith search resulting in a verifiable inventory of responsive documents. We will not contest proper redactions specified under 65 P.S. § 67.708. We undertake to pay reasonable and lawful expenses, including copying and postage, incurred in fulfilling this request.

Records were obtained via email search by the IT Department, and all documents you requested have been printed and information redacted that was personal or for medical purposes. The Finance Department also retrieved any and all invoice documents.

Please be advised that this correspondence will serve to close this record with our office as permitted by law. You have the right to appeal the Agency's response in writing to the Pennsylvania Office of Open Records, 333
